# Secret ponies in your web server







Convert view functionality  
exactly.

Minimise time between working  
PHP and working Django.

1. Neutralise the Rails fans in your team.

2. Negotiate a maintenance budget with client.

3. Start with a simple PHP script.

4. Pony up.

## 5. Deploy your Pony.

```
if /contact/:  
    django
```

```
else:  
    php
```


6. Delete some PHP :)

7. Rest and repeat.


## 8. PHP becomes the exception.

if /about/:  
    php
```

    django
```

9. You win!

**Tip:**

Start small and low priority.

**Tip:**

Take authentication away from  
PHP as soon as possible.

**Tip:**  
Phone ahead.

Mix in new shiny things.

Small sprints feel good.

New features come easy now.

**Win:**

Steady cashflow.

**Win:**

Off-peak scheduling.

**Pain point:**  
It's a marathon.

Conversion alone shows little visible progress.

**Pain point:**

Hyperlinking PHP ↔ Python.

**Pain point:**

Occasional dependency hell.
